THE WINERY

Albariño's revelation as one of the wine world's noble white varieties is due in large part to work done at this property from the mid-80s to the mid-90s. Following acquisition by Bodegas Campante of neighboring Ribeiro in 1996, a consistently balanced and refreshing style has been maintained.

THE WINE

A full-bodied, serious, dry Albariño similar to its sibling Morgadío incorporating wines made from the first pressing in a comparatively softer and more floral style.

Grapes: 100% Albariño

Vineyards: 30 hectares - southern exposure and soil of brilliantly-reflective granite sand serve to maximize the Albariño's concentration.

Production: 5,000 cases

Alcohol: 12.5%
